- A cross-cultural high school student program that provides travel, culture and community service projects whilst learning wildlife conservation.

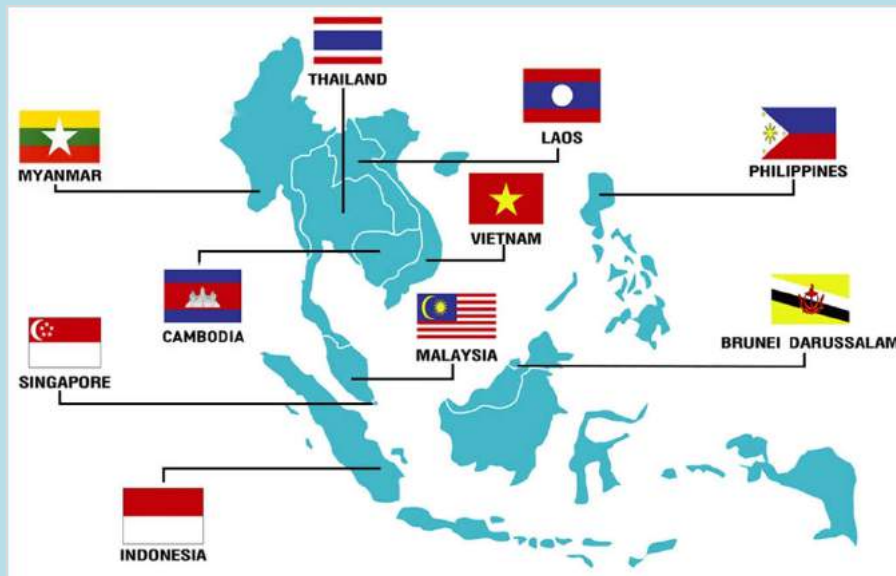
